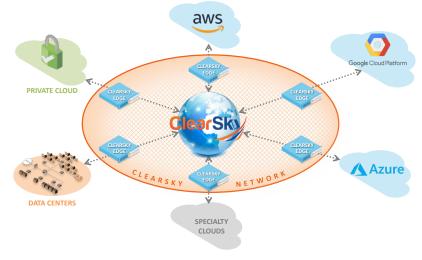
The ClearSky team set out to re-invent enterprise storage for today's business challenges. ClearSky would deliver that data as -a-service so IT teams would never have to manage storage infrastructure again and instead focus on strategic work.

The ClearSky Breakthrough: Data Storage at the Edge

In 2015, ClearSky unveiled a revolutionary storage architecture for the challenges and opportunities that businesses face today, offered as a managed service at about one third the cost of traditional storage. At its core is an edge-based storage network that delivers data in real time to applications and users while harnessing the limitless scalability, protection and accessibility only available in the cloud. By caching hot and warm data at the network edge with seamless access to all data in the cloud, ClearSky eliminates the latency challenges that previously kept cloud storage off limits for many enterprise application requirements. Since each cache layer is a superset of the previous layer, there is no need for separate primary storage, backups, DR and archives—the architecture performs all these functions automatically.
